QUINCY — The Metropolitan Boston Housing Partnership will hold a meeting about local housing concerns from 9:30 to 11 a.m. Friday, Feb. 13, at city hall.

The meeting is intended to give local residents and social service and housing providers a chance to talk about housing concerns, learn where to go for additional resources, identify gaps in services and obtain information.

The meeting is being hosted by the housing committee of the Quincy City Council and co-sponsored by Sen. Michael W. Morrissey, Father Bill's and MainSpring, Neighborhood Housing Services of the South Shore, South Shore Habitat for Humanity, South Shore Elder Services, Quincy Community Action Programs Inc., Quincy Department of Planning and Community Development, and the Quincy Housing Authority.
