

## Meeting on housing needs planned Feb. 25 at Milton town hall

MILTON — The Metropolitan Boston Housing Partnership will hold a meeting about local housing concerns from 9 to 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, Feb. 25, at the Milton Town Hall, 525 Canton Ave. The meeting was originally scheduled for Jan. 28 but postponed because of a snowstorm.

The meeting is intended to give local residents and social service and housing providers a chance to talk about housing concerns, learn where to go for additional resources, identify gaps in services and obtain information.

The meeting is being hosted by the Town of Milton Fair Housing Committee and co-sponsored by Sen. Brian A. Joyce; Reps. Linda Dorcea Forry, Angelo M. Scaccia and Walter F. Timilty; the Massachusetts Affordable Housing Alliance; the Milton Council on Aging; the Milton Housing Authority; the Milton Residents Fund; Quincy Community Action Program, Inc.; and South Shore Elder Services.

The housing partnership is a regional nonprofit housing agency. Similar meetings are planned in each of the 30 communities it serves.
