Finally . . . a free, online, real-time affordable apartment listing service for the Greater Boston region!

Since 2006, MBHP has offered free apartment listings on its website, www.mbhp.org. Now we are pleased to announce the launch of our enhanced, upgraded apartment listing service that makes it easier for property owners, property managers, prospective tenants, and housing search specialists to connect.

Consistent with MBHP's mission, this free service connects prospective tenants with affordable housing options; rents generally fall within government-set affordability ranges and apartments are located in MBHP's 30-community service area. These communities are Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Boston, Braintree, Brookline, Burlington, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Lexington, Lynn, Malden, Medford, Melrose, Milton, Newton, North Reading, Quincy, Reading, Revere, Somerville, Stoneham, Wakefield, Waltham, Watertown, Wilmington, Winchester, Winthrop and Woburn.

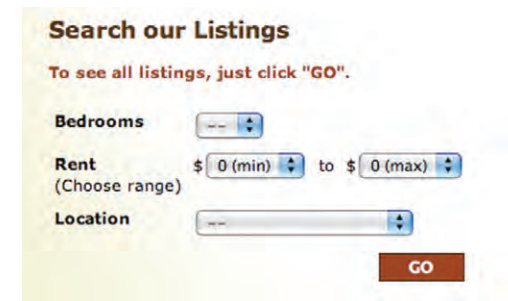


CHECK IT OUT!

Explore MBHP's free online apartment listings. Here are just some of the features and enhancements designed to make the listing service easy to use and to help you connect quickly with available apartments that meet your needs!

- **Search by bedroom number, rent range, community or any combination of the three.**
- **Access the information you need:**
 - When was the listing posted?
 - When is the apartment available?
 - Where is the apartment located?
 - What type of building is it?
 - What floor is it on?
 - How many bedrooms does it have?
 - What is the rent?
 - Are any of the utilities included?
 - Is a security deposit required?
 - Is the apartment in compliance with state lead paint laws?
 - How can I contact the property owner?
- **See a map of the apartment's neighborhood.**
- **Get directions to the apartment.**
- **See photos of the apartment if they've been provided by the property owner.**

EASY TO USE



Follow these steps to find your new home!

1. Log on to www.mbhp.org.
2. Click the "Apartment Listings" red tab near the top left of the home page.
3. Choose the number of bedrooms you want from the pull-down menu.
4. Choose your rent range from the pull-down menus.
5. Choose a community to search from the pull-down menu.
6. Press "Go."

Or, you can see all of the listings if you skip steps 3–5 and just press "Go."

Your search will show all available listings based on your search criteria. To revise your search—for example, to search listings in another community—just click on the "Apartment Listings" tab and start a new search.

To learn more about a particular listing, click "details." Listings with photos include a camera icon.

A map is included on the listing details page, as is a "Get Directions" function - just type in your current location (including ZIP code) and press "Go" for detailed directions to the apartment.
